To promote interest and involvement in Scotland's Open shows, The Scottish Kennel Club has created two competitions – Scottish Open Show Dog of the Year and Scottish Open Show Puppy of the Year. The competition will run from 1st January 2018 to 31st December 2018 and points for wins at **General or Group Society Open Shows** held in Scotland will be awarded as follows:

Rules:

- 1) Open Shows must be held in Scotland.
- 2) Open to all dogs that have accumulated points from Scottish Open Shows regardless of where they reside.
- 3) Puppies must be between 6 and 12 months of age when competing at shows during 2018, but may be over 12 months of age at the final.
- 4) Points gained from **ONE** Group Society Open Show only may be included in the points total.

The Final

The finals of both competitions will be run on the match knockout system with dogs winning the most points qualifying for the Scottish Open Show Dog of the Year competition, and the top puppies qualifying for the Scottish Open Show Puppy of the Year competition.

****Entries must be received no later than Monday, 7th January, 2019.****
