To promote interest and involvement in Scotland's Open shows, The Scottish Kennel Club has created two competitions – Scottish Open Show Dog of the Year and Scottish Open Show Puppy of the Year. The competition will run from 1st January 2017 to 31st December 2017 and points for wins at **General or Group Society Open Shows** held in Scotland will be awarded as follows:

Rules:

- 1) Open Shows must be held in Scotland.
- 2) Dog(s) / Owner(s) must be resident in Scotland when competing at the open shows.
- 3) Puppies must be between 6 and 12 months of age when competing at shows during 2017, but may be over 12 months of age at the final.
- 4) Points gained from **ONE** Group Society Open Show only may be included in the points total.

The Final

The finals of both competitions will be run on the match knockout system with dogs winning the most points qualifying for the Scottish Open Show Dog of the Year competition, and the top puppies qualifying for the Scottish Open Show Puppy of the Year competition.
